**DIED AT DAUGHTER'S HOME
NEAR WEST MIDDLETON;
FUNERAL SATURDAY.**

Mrs. Mary Elizabeth Whitaker, age 74, died at ten o'clock Thursday morning at the home of her daughter, Mrs. Burt Cedars, one mile east of West Middleton. She had been in failing health since last March and death is said to have been caused by heart trouble.

The deceased was a member of the Ingersoll Corner Christian church near Waynetown, Ind., her former home. Her husband, Aaron Whitaker, died 45 years ago and for the past eighteen years she had made her home with her children here and in the west. She had been at Mrs. Cedars' home since last May.

Surviving besides the daughter mentioned, are four children, Mrs. Everett Brown and Howard Whitaker of Ferndale, Wash., John Whitaker of Forks, Wash., and Ora Whitaker of Waynetown, Ind.; seventeen grandchildren; and three great grandchildren. A son, Tom Whitaker, was drowned nine years ago.

Funeral services will be held at 1:30 o'clock Saturday afternoon at the Cedars' home. Burial will follow in the New London cemetery.
