

# MRS. J. T. WHITE DIES

WAS LONG TIME RESIDENT OF  
WEST MIDDLETON COMMUN-  
ITY; FUNERAL MONDAY.

Mrs. Kate White, wife of J. T. White, died at 2 o'clock Saturday morning at the family home south of West Middleton, following a general decline of health which began some time ago. Had she lived until January 27 she would have been 75 years old.

Mrs. White was born in Tipton county, the daughter of Alexander and Susan Thatcher. Her marriage to Mr. White took place March 14, 1889 and all of her married life had been spent in Howard county.

Five daughters were born to Mr. and Mrs. White, they being Mrs. Arthur Horn living near West Middleton, Mrs. N. E. Lindley of Ambia, Miss Mattie White, a teacher in the Harrison township schools, Miss Daisy White, teaching in Kokomo, and Edna who died in infancy.

Surviving with the husband and four daughters are two grandchildren, Arthur Allen and Ruth Horn, one great grandchild and two brothers, William Thatcher of West Middleton and D. J. Thatcher living in the West.

Funeral services will be held at 1:30 p. m Monday at the West Middleton Friends church of which Mrs. White was a member. The Rev. Homer Biddlecum will have charge. Burial will be in the New London cemetery.
