

DIES AT AGE OF 91

MRS. FRANCES C. WHITE EXPIRES SUNDAY AT HOME OF HER DAUGHTER.

Mrs. Frances Catherine White, 91, died at 7:30 o'clock Sunday night at the home of her daughter, Mrs. Naomi Wright, 708 East Jackson street, as the result of a paralytic stroke suffered last Tuesday.

Surviving with the daughter are two sons, John White of Russellville and Lewis White living at Forest. Another son, Thomas, passed away last September. There are thirteen grandchildren, five great-grandchildren and one great-great-grandson.

Mrs. White was born October 8, 1848 in Prairie county, the daughter of David and Elizabeth Rider. When she was two years old the family moved to Howard county in which vicinity the remainder of her life had been spent. She was married in 1866 to Jesse White who died 23 years ago. As a young girl she joined the Methodist church at Forest.

She had enjoyed unusually good health for one of her years until her last illness, since which time she had been unconscious. Only a few weeks ago she came from her home at Sims to the home of her daughter.

The body has been removed to the home of her son Lewis at Forest and the funeral will be held there at 10 o'clock Tuesday morning with the Rev. N. H. Swanson, pastor of the Forest Methodist church, in charge. Burial will be in the family lot at the New London cemetery.
