

# JAMES WILSON DIES

## FORMER RESIDENT OF WEST MIDDLETON SUCCUMBS; FUNERAL TUESDAY.

Miami, Ind., Feb. 11--(Tribune Special)--James William Wilson, 82, died at the home of his niece, Mrs. Eldon Caldwell, of Miami, Saturday night at 9 o'clock.

He was the son of John and Della Wilson and was born in Rush county, April 12, 1857. At the age of three months he moved with his parents to West Middleton community where he lived until five years ago when he came to Miami to make his home with his niece.

Mr. Wilson was a member of the K. P. lodge in West Middleton for thirty-five years.

Funeral services will be held at the Caldwell home Tuesday morning at 10 o'clock, with the Rev. C. C. Fields, pastor of the Wesleyan M. E. church in charge, assisted by the Rev. J. Ross Jackson, pastor of the Methodist church of Miami. Burial will be in New London cemetery.

The body was removed to the Wayne Ladd funeral home in Miami and will be returned to the Caldwell home Monday afternoon.
