

## Adolphus J. Wright

Kokomo—Adolphus J. Wright, 82, a native of New London and for many years a resident at 830 South Buckeye street, this city, died Monday Feb. 24, at the home of his daughter, Mrs. Laodicea A. Woodard at St. Louis, Mo. He had long been in failing health.

Surviving with Mrs. Woodard are another daughter and a son, Mrs. Leland C. Johnson of Monroe, Mich., and Lowell D. Wright of Henrietta, Okla. He leaves also three sisters, Mrs. Emma Miller of Richmond, Mrs. Lenora McDaniel of New London and Mrs. Rufus Tharp of Kokomo.
