

JOHN WRIGHT EXPIRES

RUSSIAVILLE RESIDENT DIES
LATE THURSDAY NIGHT;
FUNERAL SUNDAY.

Russiaville, Ind., March 3—¹⁹³⁸ (Tribune Special)—John Wright, residing northwest of Russiaville, died at 10:30 o'clock Thursday night. He was almost 67 years old.

He had been ill for several years and bedfast since Sunday. He had lived in the western part of Howard county most of his life.
