Omer N. Zell, 80, 2507 N. Bell St., was dead on arrival at St. Joseph Memorial Hospital at 10:50 a.m. Monday, Jan. 14, 1980, after being stricken with an apparent attack at Cognata's Green House, where he was a part-time employee.
