## KOKOMO WOMAN, FORMER RESIDENT OF MIAMI VICIN- ITY, DIES THURSDAY.

Mrs. Flora Banner, age sixty-one, of 821 North McCann street, died at her home Thursday morning at 6 o'clock, following an illness of about a year.

The deceased is survived by the husband, John W. Banner, and six children. They include three sons, Paul Banner of near Miami, Edwin and Ernest Banner at home and three daughters, Mrs. Lena King, Mrs. Mary Fewell and Mrs. Martha Weaver of Kokomo.

She leaves also three brothers, Fred, William and Robert Gordon and a sister, Mrs. Mary Frances Porter, of Spokane, Wash. There are ten grandchildren and two great grandchildren.

Mrs. Banner was born in Ervin township, Howard county, the daughter of Henry and Elmira Gordon. Her married life was spent mostly in Miami county, the family living on a farm near Miami for twenty-eight years. Prior to that they had lived in the Kappa community. Two years ago they moved to Kokomo.

Mrs. Banner was a life-long of the Friends church. Funeral services will be held at Bethel church, eleven miles northwest of Kokomo with the Rev. Thomas Newlin in charge and burial will be in North Union cemetery, but the time for the last rites has not been determined.
