## J. WILLIAM BANNER.

J. William Banner, 83, retired farmer, died at 5:56 o'clock Tuesday afternoon at the home of his daughter, Mrs. Mary Fewell, 403 North Philips street, of bronchial pneumonia. His own home was at 1111 North McCann street.

Mr. Banner was born in 1862 near Winston-Salem, N. C., the son of John William and Mary Jane Banner. He came to the Kokomo community in 1884 and for a number of years was a resident and prominent farmer in Miami county. He moved to Kokomo in 1928.

He was married February 14, 1893, to Flora Alice Gordon who died April 21, 1932. Later he married Mary F. Dailey who survives as the widow. Surviving also are six children of the first marriage, Paul E. Banner of Peru, Mrs. Lena A. Widner, Mrs. Mary Fewell, Mrs. Martha E. Weaver, William Ernest and Clarence Edwin Banner, all of Kokomo. There are 22 grandchildren, 14 great-grandchildren and several nephews and nieces. He leaves also one sister, Mrs. Ellen Salmons of Kokomo. Two sisters are deceased, Mrs. Adalaide Woolley and Mrs. Nevada Pfaff.

Mr. Banner was a member of the Christian church and of the Masonic lodge.

The body will be returned to the home of Mrs. Fewell at 10:30 o'clock Thursday morning, after which friends may call. Funeral services with the Masonic ritual will be held at 2 o'clock Friday afternoon at the Rich funeral chapel. Burial will be in North Union cemetery.
