

## WONDERFUL FATALITY.

### Sudden Deaths in the Boswell Family.

The following sad facts we have from Mr. W. T. Merrell, of North Ervin:

Hiram Boswell, an old citizen about sixty, his wife, Rachel, a year or two older, and their oldest son, W. H. Boswell, about thirty-five, died of pneumonia within the short space of three or four days. The senior Mr. Boswell and his son were buried on Friday, two weeks ago, and the wife and mother on the following Sunday. Neither of the three lived a week after being attacked. The old folks were highly respected and had reared a family of seven children, besides the one now deceased, all of whom are grown. W. H. and his family, a wife and two children, lived at Flora, in Carroll county. He had come over to visit his parents, was taken sick, and could not return.
