Mrs. Ida Campbell Dies Early Sunday

Ida Campbell, age 70, passed away at her home, 1039 South Purdum street, at 2:05 Sunday morning. She had been in ill health for the past three years but had been confined to her home only for the past four days.

Mrs. Campbell was born April 15, 1873, to William and Hulda Coy. She was married in 1890 to Free-mont Campbell, who preceded her in death 24 years ago. The year following the death of her husband Mrs. Campbell came to Kokomo, where she has made her home ever since. She was a devout member of the Pilgrim Holiness church and was on her way to services at the church when stricken with her last illness.

Surviving are three daughters, Mrs. Joe Thompson of Kokomo, Mrs. Clifford Moss of Galveston, and Mrs. Harry Tilley of Gatesville, Texas. Surviving also is one sister, Mrs. William Sullivan of Indianapolis. There are also several grandchildren, nieces and nephews.
