# DEATH CAME TO A WELL-KNOWN FARMER

William Dillard Passes Away At  
Home Near Kappa.

William Dillard, aged forty-eight, a resident upon the J. R. Johnson farm near Kappa, died this afternoon, at 3:25 o'clock, of paralysis, after an illness of several weeks. Mr. Dillard was a widower, his wife having died suddenly four years ago, while out in the barn lot of their home near Young America.

The funeral will be held at the church in Kappa, Friday morning, at 10 o'clock. Rev. McFarland of New London will conduct the services.

The deceased is survived by three children, Fred, aged twenty-one years, Ray, aged seven years, and Eva, eighteen years old. Mrs. Jennie Dillard, the aged mother, who lives in Orleans, Orange county, also survives. There are four brothers surviving, who live at the same point, they being Sam, Charles, Ed and John. There are two sisters to mourn the loss of a brother, they being Mrs. Emma Marshall of Chalmers, White county, and Miss Jane Dillard of the same place.
