

### MRS. LAURA GANNON.

Mrs. Laura Gannon, 76, a lifelong resident of Howard county, died Tuesday night at the home of her daughter, Mrs. Clarence Merrell, in Ervin township, where she had been visiting. Death followed a heart attack. She had been in ill health some time.

Surviving are four daughters, Mrs. Merrell, Mrs. Ray Blangy of Ervin township, Mrs. Luis Bustamante of Columbia, South America, and Mrs. Ray Elleman of Kokomo. There are six grandchildren and two great-grandchildren. One brother survives also, Edward Crites, of Cass county.
