

Anthony Garbert, 83, Expires of Cancer At Local Hospital

Anthony William Garbert, 83, a retired farmer, died at the Good Samaritan hospital at 11:25 o'clock Thursday night of cancer. He had been taken to the hospital from his home, 1230 South Courtland avenue, four days ago. *d. 4-11-40*
