

DEATH TAKES MOTHER

MRS. HOWARD GILBERT EX-PIRES LEAVING SEVEN CHILDREN.

Mrs. Louella Gilbert, age thirty-seven years, wife of Howard Gilbert, a detective of the local police department, died at 1:30 o'clock Wednesday afternoon at the family home, 1032 South McCann street. Death came unexpectedly as the result of complications that followed the birth of a baby last Saturday.

Surviving with the husband are a son Robert and six daughters, Betty Jane, Marjorie Ann, Ellen, Jean, Rosemary and Patsy who is four days old. She leaves also a brother, John Addler of Peoria, Ill., and three sisters, Mrs. Irene Williams of Kokomo, Mrs. Hazel Helton of Evanston, Ill., and Mrs. Katherine Kirby of Chicago.
