PNEUMONIA CAUSES DEATH OF WIDOW OF FORMER KOKOMO RESIDENT

Miami, Ind., May 6—(Tribune Special)—Mrs. Agnes E. Price, 52, died at the home of her brother, Leslie M. Marquand, Wednesday morning at 8 o'clock, following several days' illness of pneumonia. She had been an invalid for two years.

The deceased was the daughter of Louis and Catherine Marquand and was born and reared in Ervin township, Howard county. She was born Dec. 21, 1883.

On Nov. 5, 1927, she was married to Charles H. Price of Kokomo and the couple resided there until his death Feb. 22, 1935, since which time she made her home with her brother in Miami. Her only near survivor besides the brother are and aunt, Mrs. Ida Young of Kappa and an uncle, Charles Marquand who lives in Canada.

Funeral services will be held at the Methodist Episcopal church in Miami Saturday morning at 10 o'clock, followed by burial in North Union cemetery, ten miles west of Kokomo. The Rev. J. Ross Jackson will officiate.

The body was removed to the Wayne Ladd funeral home on highway 3 and will be returned to the home of the brother Thursday morning.
