

## Schroeter services

Services for Kurt Schroeter, 81, 6750 W. Road 400 North, will be at 10 a.m. Saturday in Zion Lutheran Church. The Rev. Donald Studt will officiate. Burial will be in North Union Cemetery. Friends may call from 2 to 4 and 6 to 9 p.m. Friday at Ellers Mortuary and one hour before services at the church Saturday.

Schroeter died at 7:15 a.m. Wednesday, Dec. 2, 1987, in Saint Joseph Hospital & Health Center. He was born March 30, 1906, in Germany, a son of Albin and Livia (Schnabel) Schroeter.

March 24, 1940, he married Mary Louise Pohlman, who died May 15, 1982.

A farmer, Schroeter had also worked for National Kongress Railroad and as a Pinkerton guard. He was a member of Zion Lutheran Church, German Club DANK and sang in the church choir.

Surviving are a son, Albert Schroeter of Kokomo; a daughter, Hilda Schroeter of Kokomo; two brothers, Hans Schroeter of Kokomo and Albert Schroeter of East Germany; two sisters, Maria Giinther of Drakenburg, West Germany, and Hilda Erler of East Germany; and five grandchildren.
