Lee R. Simpson, 72, 1849 W. Road 300 North, died at 12:10 a.m. Tuesday, Jan. 21, 1997, at Methodist Hospital, Indianapolis. On June 23, 1924 in Howard County, he was born to Claude H. and Lula A. (McKibben) Simpson. On Jan. 22, 1956 he married Peggy A. Goldsberry; she survives.

He hauled livestock for area farmers and local packing houses. He later managed the Izaak Walton League for nine years. He graduated
