Robert A. Goodnight, 73, 508 Holly Lane, died at 9:50 a.m. Monday, Jan. 22, 1990, in Windsor Estates.

He was born Oct. 24, 1916, in Clinton County, the son of Lincoln and Clara (James) Goodnight. May 24, 1941, he married Phoebe Inman, who survives.

Goodnight retired in 1975 from department 35 of Chrysler Corp. after 37½ years

of service. He was an Army veteran of World War II and a 1935 graduate of Russiaville High School. He had lived in Howard County most of his life except from 1977 to 1988 when he lived in Sarasota, Fla.

He was a 50-year member of Russiaville Masonic Lodge 82, a charter member of American Legion Floyd Marshall Post 412, a life member of Veterans of Foreign Wars Post 3233 of Sarasota and a member of Russiaville United Methodist Church and United Auto Workers Local 685.

Also surviving are two daughters, Nancy Hobson and Donna Chambers, both of Russiaville; three sisters, Marianna Taylor, Berniece Goodnight and Betty Jo Hardie, all of Kokomo; and six grandchildren.
