

L. DORUS MARSHALL

L. Dorus Marshall, 55, residing on Russiaville route 1, died about 9:30 o'clock Sunday night at Memorial hospital, Logansport. He had not been in good health for several years, suffering from a heart ailment which was the ultimate cause of his death.

Mr. Marshall was born April 27, 1895, in Ervin township, the eldest of five children of William and Emma Marshall. He spent practically his entire life in Howard or adjoining counties, always engaged in farming.

December 24, 1921, he married Lucy Rice of the Beard community. They established residence west of Russiaville where they lived for about 16 years. The next 12 years they lived in or near Galveston, returning about a year ago to the Russiaville community.

Mr. Marshall was a member and past master of the Russiaville Masonic lodge. 4-9-1951

Surviving with the widow are three brothers, Lloyd and Glen of Russiaville and Kenneth of Rossville. There are seven nieces and nephews. The body is at the Stout & Son funeral home in Russiaville where service will be held at 1:30 o'clock Wednesday afternoon with the Rev. Franklin Arthur of Tipton officiating.
