

Milo M. McKinney, Russiaville, Dies ^{Mar.} ¹⁹⁶⁷

Milo M. McKinney, 62, Russiaville, died in Wabash Valley sanitarium at Lafayette at 1:45 o'clock Wednesday afternoon. He had been ill for the past three years and bedfast for three weeks. He was admitted to the sanitarium Tuesday afternoon.

The deceased was born April 5, 1888, in Russiaville and was reared there. He was the son of Mr. and Mrs. William C. McKinney. He traveled for the Alladin Lamp company for 15 years until three years ago, when he was forced to retire on account of ill health.

He was married to Margaret Mills of Decatur, Ind., who died June 14, 1941. There are no children.
