LEBANON, Ohio — Marie Walker McNeal, 97, 585 N. State Road, formerly of Howard County, died at 9 p.m. Wednesday, June 28, 1995, at Otterbein Retirement Community Health Care.

Born Oct. 3, 1897, in Arthur, Ill., she was a daughter of Willis Jasper and Cynthia Ellen (Fulfer) Walker. In 1921 she married Raymond L. "Mac" McNeal, who died in 1950.

She was a retired school teacher. She also worked as a social worker for the Howard County Welfare Department. She attended Tri-State College and Muncie Teachers Institute. She was a 30-year member of Belmont United Methodist Church in Dayton and a 75-year member of Russiaville Order of Eastern Star. She was the first lady appointed by Gov. Schricker Farmer Field women for Indiana Soil Conservation. She also taught Sunday school at New London Friends Church.

Surviving are a son and daughter-in-law, George L. and Mary McNeal, Camarillo, Calif.; a daughter and son-in-law, Mrs. Raymond (Marjorie McNeal) Clawson, Kettering, Ohio; four grandchildren and their spouses; and two great-grandchildren. A brother, Charles Walker, and a sister, Harriet King, preceded her in death.
