

MRS. MARGARET MEDLEY EX-PIRES AFTER LONG ILLNESS; RITES TO BE THURSDAY

Russiaville, Ind., Jan. 18—(Tribune Special)—Mrs. Margaret Duncan Medley, 59, widow of John E. Medley, died at 2 o'clock Tuesday morning at her home in Russiaville, where she had resided for 21 years. She had been ill for several weeks, her condition becoming serious a week ago.

Mrs. Medley was the mother of five children, three of whom preceded her in death. Surviving her are her son, Marion Duncan, at home, and her daughter, Mrs. James Wyrick of Russiaville; also two step grandchildren, Kathleen and Max Shumaker, whom she reared in her home, giving them every possible advantage in education and in music. Mrs. Medley loved art and music and did what she could to promote them in her home and her community. She was a member of the Christian church.
