

MILTON MYERS DIES

RUSSIAVILLE MAN SUCCUMBS TO HEART DISEASE; FU- NERAL SATURDAY.

Russiaville, Ind., March 2.—Milton Myers, 65, died at his home here at 5:15 o'clock Thursday morning, following an illness of several weeks of heart trouble. He was born in Cues county on June 24, 1873, but long had been a resident of this community.

He was a member of the Baptist church and of the Russiaville I. O. O. F. lodge, joining the latter 33 years ago.

Funeral services will be held at 1:30 o'clock Saturday afternoon at the Baptist church, followed by burial in the Russiaville cemetery.

Mr. Myers was married twice, his first wife, Jessie Butler Myers, passing away in 1904. He married Miss Ottie Michael in 1906. No children were born, but two nieces, Mrs. Bessie Powell of Camden and Mrs. Helen May of New Albany, were reared in his home.

Surviving with the widow are his mother, Mrs. Amanda Myers, who lived in his home; a sister, Mrs. Lillie Coder of Lucerne, and a brother, Walter Myers of Kokomo, with a number of nieces and nephews.
