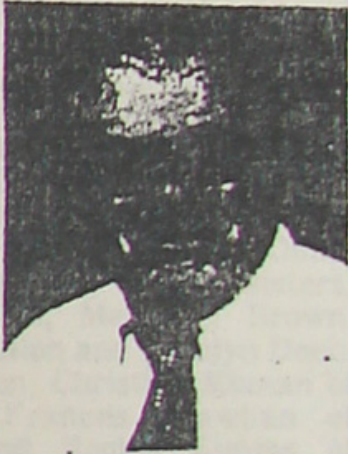


Kenneth Carter
