

## Roy E. Carter

Roy Edgar Carter, 62, Kokomo R.R. 5, died at 9:30 a.m. Monday, Sept. 5, 1977, in St. Joseph Memorial Hospital following an extended illness.

Born April 25, 1915, in Monticello, Ky., he was the son of Obie and Lee-Anth (Guffey) Carter. He was married Oct. 21, 1956, to Freda Price, who survives.
