

## HERBERT C. CHAPMAN

Herbert C. Chapman, 57, 1319 S. Purdum St., died at 2:30 p. m. Wednesday at the St. Joseph Hospital where he had been a patient for the last two and a half weeks. His health had been failing for the last four years and upon becoming critical he was removed to the hospital.

He was born June 5, 1900 in Blairsville Pa., the son of Mr. and Mrs. William L. Chapman and came to Kokomo to live in 1929. He was employed in the hot mill of the Continental Steel Corporation and worked until three weeks ago.

Mr. Chapman was in the army during World War I and was a member of the American Legion, World War I Veterans, Eagles and Moose Lodges. He was a member of the Episcopalian Church of Leachburg, Pa.

On May 4, 1948 he was married to Cora Jane Warwick who is the only survivor. A daughter, Mary Esther, died in infancy and both parents and two sisters preceded him in death.

Funeral services will be at the Fenn Funeral Home at 2 p. m. Saturday with the Rev. Richard E. Cooper officiating followed by burial in the Sunset Memory Gardens.
