

# Ray Clark

VALPARAISO, Ind. — Ray V. Clark, 82, 169 Jamestown Ave., died at 1:58 p.m. Monday, Aug. 1, 1988, in Porter Memorial Hospital here.

He was born Nov. 28, 1905, in Kokomo, a son of Clarence and Laura (Snideman) Clark. May 12, 1928, he married Elizabeth A. Hoppe, who died June 26, 1977.

In 1968 Clark retired from Continental Steel Corp. at Kokomo after 36 years of service in the wire galvanized department.
