

## Fred Lewis Coleman

PINELLAS PARK, Fla. — Fred Lewis Coleman, 86, 3401 Gandy Blvd. N. and formerly of Kokomo, Ind., died at St. Anthony's Hospital in St. Petersburg at 5:23 p.m. Monday, Oct. 11, 1982, following a brief illness. 13 OCT 1982

He was born in Tipton County, Ind., Sept. 1, 1896, the son of David and Mary (Pyke) Coleman. He was married July 26, 1919, to Fairy V. Stephenson, who survives.
