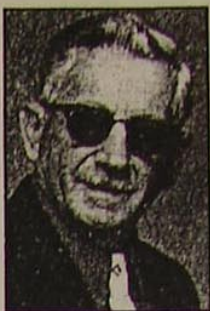


## Charles F. Colvin
