

# Kenneth Cooper

Kenneth Cooper, 70, Elletton, Fla., died Saturday at the Manatee Memorial Hospital, Bradenton Fla.

He was born Nov. 8, 1900, in Cripple Creek, Colo., the son of Charles and Julia (Burger) Cooper. He was married to Fannie Edison, who survives.
