

Herbert Cuttriss, Florist, To Be Buried Wednesday

Funeral services for Herbert J. Cuttriss, 84, 1208 E. Mulberry St., operator of a florist business adjoining his home here for many years, will be at 2 p.m. Wednesday in the Ellers Funeral Chapel. Burial will be in Sunset Memory Gardens Cemetery.

Mr. Cuttriss died Monday morning at his home following an extended illness.

Born in Dover, Kent, England, Nov. 30, 1881, he was the son of James and Katherine Cuttriss. As a young man, he left England to make his home in Canada and he came to reside in the United States approximately 50 years ago.

In 1914 he was married to Elsie Rogers and he has been a resident of Kokomo since 1919.

He was a member of the Loyal Order of the Moose.

Surviving with the widow are two sons, Jack Cuttriss and Alan Cuttriss, both of Kokomo; nine grandchildren; two foster-grandchildren and three great-grandchildren.
