

JACK J. CUTTRISS

May 27, 1915 - Aug. 10, 2006

Kokomo resident Jack J. Cuttriss, 91, went home to be with the Lord at 5:45 a.m. Thursday, Aug. 10, 2006, while residing at Sycamore Village Health Care in Kokomo. He was born on May 27, 1915, the son of Herbert J. and Elsie P. (Rogers) Cuttriss in Oil City, Penn. On Aug. 25, 1939, he married Dorothy Young at First Baptist Church in Kokomo, and she preceded him in death on Aug. 21, 2005.

Jack worked for Continental Steel for 42½ years as a clerk in the Rod Mill, before retiring in 1977. He was a faithful member of First Baptist Church and received his 50-year membership certificate.
