

# Funeral Services Set For Explosion Victim

Saturday afternoon funeral services have been scheduled for Stuart M. Ellsworth, 44, 2222 S. Indiana Ave. who died in an explosion at a Stellite Division plant Thursday morning.

Services will be at 3 p.m. in the First Presbyterian Church where he was an elder and a deacon. Officiating will be Dr. Harry S. Walrond. Burial will be in Sunset Memory Gardens Cemetery.

Friends may call at Ellers Funeral Chapel after 4 p.m. Friday.

Ellsworth, who was an engineer in Stellite's salvage and reclamation department, had been employed by the company since Sept. 16, 1946.

He was a graduate of Lehigh University in Bethlehem, Pa., and of Plainfield High School in Connecticut. During World War II he was a U.S. Navy lieutenant, serving in the Pacific for two years and engaging in heavy combat duty in that area.

Born Dec. 13, 1921 in Central Village, Conn., he was the son of Stuart M. Sr. and Louise (Tillinghast) Ellsworth. He was married in 1949 to the former Miss Constance Robinson.

Surviving with Ellsworth's wife and his mother, who lives in Central Village, are two daughters, Mary Louise and Carol; a son, Stuart M. Ellsworth III; and a sister, Mrs. William (Priscilla) King of Northampton, Mass.
