


Harrell services

 Services for Clarence Earl Harrell, 81, 2143 N. Waugh St., will be at 1 p.m. Monday in Sunset Mausoleum Chapel. The Rev. Harold Williams will officiate. Friends may call at Eilers Mortuary from 5 to 7 p.m. today. Burial will be at Sunset Memory Gardens Cemetery.

Harrell died at 1:45 p.m. on Friday, Aug. 23, 1991, at his residence. He was born June 16, 1910, in New London, Ind., the son of Earnest and Bessie (Waters) Harrell. May 16, 1942, he married Pauline Petkovsek, who survives.
