Charles N. "Chuck" Henderson, 69, 891 Exeter Turn-C 1, Bourbonnais, Ill., formerly of Kokomo, died 7:36 p.m. Friday, Dec. 22, 2000, at Provena Heritage Village Health Care, Kankakee, Ill.
