



**MRS. M. D. HOLLINGSWORTH**

Mrs. Helen A. Hollingsworth, 53, wife of Morris D. Hollingsworth, of the New London community, died early Sunday morning.

She was enroute by air from her home here to visit her sister, Mrs. Beryl Gordon at Phoenix, Ariz., when stricken with a heart attack. Death came in the Ayman Carter air terminal in Fort Worth, Tex., where she was changing planes.

The body will be brought to the Ellers Mortuary in Kokomo. Funeral arrangements will be made later.

Mrs. Hollingsworth was the daughter of Frank and Alice (Davis) Haworth and was born on the farm east of New London where she still resided.

Surviving are the husband and two sons, John, stationed at Fort Devens, Mass., and Richard of Fairborn, Ohio. There are two grandchildren, David and Diane of Fairborn, O., also the sister, Mrs. Edgar Gordon of Phoenix, Ariz.

Mrs. Hollingsworth was a graduate of the New London High School and Indiana University, with an AB degree from the latter.

She was a member of the New London Friends Church, of the local chapter of the AAUW and of the IU chapter of the Kappa Delta Sorority.

She had been an active worker in the Red Cross, serving on the local board at one time and was in Home Demonstration Club work.
