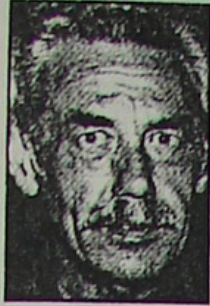


Joseph Simcheck Jr.
